Section 73 of the Northern Territory *Local Government Act* states:

#### Section 73 Conflict of interest

- (1) A member has a **conflict of interest** in a question arising for decision by the council, local board or council committee if the member or an associate of the member has a personal or financial interest in how the question is decided.
- (2) This section does not apply if the interest is:
  - (a) an interest in a question about the level of allowances or expenses to be set for members; or
  - (b) an interest that the member or associate shares in common with the general public or a substantial section of the public; or
  - (c) an interest as an elector or ratepayer that the member or associate shares in common with other electors or ratepayers; or
  - (d) an interest that the member or an associate has in a non-profit body or association; or
  - (e) an interest of the member or an associate:
    - (i) in appointment or nomination for appointment to a body with predominantly charitable objects; or
    - (ii) in payment or reimbursement of membership fees, or expenses related to membership, in such a body; or
  - (f) an interest so remote or insignificant that it could not reasonably be regarded as likely to influence a decision.

#### Section 74 Disclosure of interest

- (1) As soon as practicable after a member becomes aware of a conflict of interest in a question that has arisen or is about to arise before the council, local board or council committee, the member must disclose the personal or financial interest that gives rise to the conflict (the **relevant interest**):
  - (a) at a meeting of the council, local board or council committee; and
  - (b) to the CEO.

(2) The CEO must record the disclosure in a register of interests kept for the purpose.

Section 12 of the Northern Territory Local Government (Administration) Regulations states:

**Section 12 Contents of register of interests**

The register of interests to be kept under section 74(2) of the Act must contain:

- (a) the name of the member making the disclosure; and
- (b) the nature of the interest that gives rise to the conflict of interest; and
- (c) the nature of the question on which the conflict of interest arises.

**TITLE:** Purchase of New Garbage Truck  
**AUTHOR:** Nyaradzo Musasira, Governance & Compliance Coordinator

### **PURPOSE**

This report is provided to Council to request Councils approval to purchase a new garbage truck for \$450 000 for the Community of Wurrumiyanga.

### **BACKGROUND**

Wurumiyanga's garbage truck has been out of service for several weeks. The truck has had ongoing electrical problems caused by wear and tear due to the age of the truck and climatic conditions

Council purchased the Wurrumiyanga garbage truck as new in 2015 and has relied on this truck for waste management for the past nine (9) years. The general practise by other councils is to renew garbage trucks every two (2) to three (3) years.

The council has an obligation to the upkeep of the environmental health and safety of the Wurrumiyanga land and its people. Further, the practice of the Town Services team loading community bins by hand poses a significant work health and safety issue.

At Council's 24 September Ordinary Council Meeting, Council resolved to ask the Wurrumiyanga Local Authority (WLA) to consider the purchase of a new garbage truck using Local Authority Project Funds (LAPF). A Special WLA meeting was held on Tuesday 7 October 2024 and at this meeting it was agreed that a new garbage truck would be purchased for the Wurrumiyanga community.

### **ISSUES/OPTIONS/CONSEQUENCES**

The Wurrumiyanga garbage truck was purchased in 2015 for approximately \$230,000. Since then, equipment prices have risen considerably with quotes indicating the estimated cost of a new garbage truck (including freight) to be \$450,000. (Noting the quoted truck has a greater volume which will reduce travel to the waste site and accommodate the proposed Wurrumiyanga town development.)

Officers have considered refurbishing the truck. The advantage of refurbishment is it will be less costly. However, it means that there will be no garbage truck for an extended period, and this is considered unacceptable operationally and by the community.

With the high cost of the truck and significant investment of funds the purchase represents, WLA members asked Officers to ensure that a truck would be maintained adequately, and the truck would remain in the Wurrumiyanga community. A plan is to be put in place for the maintenance of the new truck and it was agreed that only trained personnel will be operating the new machine, and employees will be trained in how to operate the truck in due course. The truck will be parked at the Depot every afternoon and there will be security cameras for security purposes.

The purchase price of the truck is approximately \$450,000. Council purchases over \$250,000 fall outside the Chief Executive Officers financial delegation. Under the Local Government Act 2019 (Section 40 Delegation), the CEO has the authority to be delegated the power to enter into a contract below the threshold value determined by Council. The

Council's Financial Delegations Policy limits this value to \$250,000. As this contract exceeds the CEO's delegation threshold, the Council is required to endorse it.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

**That Council accept the purchase of the new garbage truck for a provisional amount of \$450 000 using the Local Authority Project Fund as agreed to by the Wurrimiyanga Local Authority.**

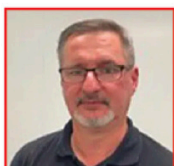

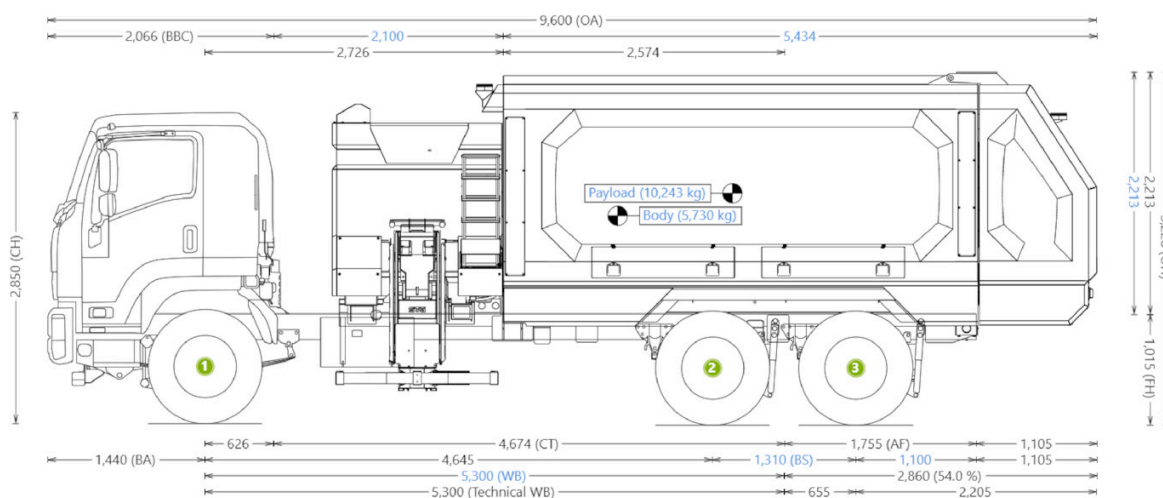
